CPT stated there was no reason to read SPC his rights, due to this investigation having been ruled as Justifiable Homicide. 

- 1. On 12 Jun 03, two detainess escaped Camp Cropper. They were observed running away from the detaines area by SPC 186<sup>th</sup> MP Co, who was on exterior guard duty. He fired a total of four rounds at the two escapees, striking one twice (once in the back and once in the legs). The escapee (Ajkel Abedal Hussein Jabar, #7166) died from his wounds.
- 2. CPT MI was appointed as the 15-6 officer and investigated the incident. According to ACI2 and all available records no formal CID ROI was initiated to investigate the incident. CPT Command Judge 670-3, 66-3 Advocate. Camp Cropper provided the SJA review/opinion.
