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INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

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THIS IS AN OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM INVESTIGATION.

On 9 JAN 04, the 94th Military Police Company, FOB Rifles Base, Al Asad, Iraq, notified this office an Iraqi detainee died at the FOB Rifles Base detention facility.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SPC [REDACTED] committed the offense of assault when shortly after the capture of Mr. [REDACTED] SPC [REDACTED] kicked Mr. [REDACTED] in the chest two or three times. SPC [REDACTED] stated the reason for the assault was to stop Mr. [REDACTED] from standing. Mr. [REDACTED] was restrained with zip ties at the time of the assault.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SFC [REDACTED], SFC [REDACTED] and SSG [REDACTED] committed the offenses of aggravated assault, conspiracy, and false official statement when they entered into an agreement to provide a uniformed statement as to the alleged attack on SFC [REDACTED] by Mr. [REDACTED]. All three then provided official statements stating Mr. [REDACTED] attacked SFC [REDACTED] and attempted to reach for the pistol located in his shoulder holster. They stated they had to subdue Mr. [REDACTED] by striking Mr. [REDACTED] repeatedly for one to two minutes. SSG [REDACTED] SFC [REDACTED] and SFC [REDACTED] stated they never attempted to gain control of Mr. [REDACTED] hands in order to prevent him from reaching for the weapon. Mr. [REDACTED] injuries were not consistent with this explanation in that the number of injuries and severity of the injuries exceeded the force that would reasonably be required for three men to subdue him.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SPC [REDACTED] committed the offenses of aggravated assault, conspiracy, and false official statement; spc king committed the offense of false official statement and conspiracy; SPC [REDACTED] committed the offenses of false official statement and conspiracy; and SSG [REDACTED] committed the offenses of dereliction of duty, conspiracy, and false official statement when they entered into an agreement prior to being interviewed by CID, that they would not disclose the fact that Mr. [REDACTED] actually made it outside the detention facility during his escape attempt. SPC [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] have stated SPC [REDACTED] apprehended Mr. [REDACTED] alone by grabbing his shoulders from behind, causing Mr. [REDACTED] to fall backwards in a twisting motion onto his buttocks. At which time SPC [REDACTED] stepped over, or around him, to a position near Mr. [REDACTED]'s legs and feet. SPC [REDACTED] then escorted Mr. [REDACTED] to the sleep deprivation area located directly in front of the guard stand. However, SSG [REDACTED] stated SPC [REDACTED] caught Mr. [REDACTED] prior to him leaving the building. SSG [REDACTED] stated upon first contact, SPC [REDACTED] slammed Mr. [REDACTED] into the back wall, and then bear hugged Mr. [REDACTED] from behind and slammed him to the floor with SPC [REDACTED] standing on top of Mr. [REDACTED]. Further, SSG [REDACTED] failed to initially report how SPC [REDACTED] apprehended Mr. [REDACTED] during the escape attempt.

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Investigation established probable cause to believe PFC [REDACTED] committed the offense of negligent homicide when he utilized a Military Police style baton to bring Mr. [REDACTED] to his feet after he refused to stand. SPC [REDACTED] stated PFC [REDACTED] appeared to be very upset about the escape attempt and when Mr. [REDACTED] refused to stand PFC [REDACTED] placed the baton under the chin of Mr. [REDACTED], while standing behind him, and pulled him to a standing position, thereby fracturing the hyoid bone, which was the major contributing factor for the death of Mr. [REDACTED]. Further investigation established probable cause to believe PFC [REDACTED] committed the offense of conspiracy when he entered into an agreement with SPC [REDACTED], SSG [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] prior to being interviewed by CID, in that they would not disclose the fact that Mr. [REDACTED] actually made it outside the detention facility during his escape attempt.

Investigation established probable cause to believe SGT [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] committed the offense of negligent homicide and cruelty and maltreatment when they ordered Mr. [REDACTED] to stand as part of a mass punishment, then after Mr. [REDACTED] failed to comply with their order they handcuffed Mr. [REDACTED] to the door frame of his cell in such a manner to force him to remain standing. SGT [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] then gagged Mr. [REDACTED] after he refused to stop making noises. SPC [REDACTED] stood behind Mr. [REDACTED] with the gag around Mr. [REDACTED]'s head, as SGT [REDACTED] utilized pressure points on the upper jaw and chin to force his mouth open. SPC [REDACTED] then pulled the gag into place and tied it off behind Mr. [REDACTED] head.

Considering the totality of the facts and events regarding the detention of Mr. [REDACTED] there was no one incident which caused the final demise of Mr. [REDACTED]. Rather he was steadily subjected to physical trauma, brought on by his own actions; however, excessive force was utilized by SSG [REDACTED], SFC [REDACTED], and SFC [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED] and PFC [REDACTED]. There is indication to suggest SGT [REDACTED] or SPC [REDACTED] acted in a negligent manner when they gagged and forced Mr. [REDACTED] to stand as punishment for talking. The initial incident with SPC [REDACTED] was deemed insignificant to cause grievous bodily injury from eye witness statements, from members of his unit, and from the interviews of the other Iraqis detained at the same time as Mr. [REDACTED].

Further investigation was to document final SJA coordination, CRC name checks and clarification of questions from an operational review of the final report.
