

HUMAN RIGHTS SQUARES¹

This adapted activity is borrowed from human rights field to introduce students to different topics of Children's rights. Instructions: Using members of the group as sources of information, get an answer for as many squares as you can and write it in the square. Each answer should come from a different person, who must initial that square for you. Stop when time is called.
