**SEX DISQUALIFICATION REMOVAL**

*Ordinance*  
No. 25 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE TO ENABLE WOMEN TO BE ADMITTED TO  
THE LEGAL PROFESSION AND TO BE APPOINTED AS  
COMMISSIONERS FOR OATHS.

[ 14th November, 1933.]

Short title.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Sex Disqualifi-  
cation Removal (Legal Profession) Ordinance.

Women entitled to  
become attomeys-  
at-law, &c.

**2.** A woman shall not be disqualified by reason only of  
her sex—

- (a) from being admitted and enrolled, or from practising,  
as an attorney-at-law; or
- (b) from being authorized to practise as a notary by a  
warrant issued under the provisions of the Notaries  
Ordinance, or from practising or functioning as a  
notary under the provisions of that Ordinance or of  
any other written law; or,
- (c) from being appointed, or from functioning, as a  
Commissioner for Oaths under the provisions of the  
Oaths Ordinance.
